We are really looking forward to our new term and are excited to announce our new topic is Superheroes! This term we have plans for an exciting trip!

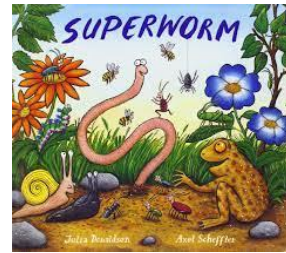
Superheroes
