Dear Families,

Year 6 will be attending a World War Two experience day at the Museum of Kent Life on Tuesday 20th May. The children will take part in a variety of workshops across the day which will include activities to show them a glimpse of life in WW2, from evacuation to RAF Navigation and even a tractor/train ride.

We will be leaving school early, so your child will need to be in school to be registered at **8.30am**. The coach will be leaving at **8.45am** prompt. Due to the time of the workshops and traffic conditions, we will not be able to wait if your child is late and will have to leave without them. We aim to return to school at around **3.45pm**, but will keep parents informed via Arbor if we are delayed. The children will need to be collected from the Pysons Road gate.

As part of this experience day, the children will need to dress up in WW2 costume. This does not need to be a brand-new, expensive costume and could be made up using old clothes. Please see below some possible ideas.



Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (please ensure you have indicated your child's choice on the consent form online). This lunch will need to be brought in a bag as they will have to carry it with them. When walking around the museum site and between activities, the children will be outside, so please ensure that they will be warm enough and provide a waterproof coat/jacket for any rain.

The cost of the trip is £18.50*, available to pay online using Arbor. The children do not need any other money for this trip.

*No child will be refused participation on the grounds of being unable to make a contribution, but if insufficient contributions are received, we would need to consider cancelling the trip. If you have any difficulties with the cost of the trip, please do not hesitate to speak to Nichola Sturges, our Family Liaison Officer and we will do our best to sort something out for you.
