- Astro off cuts, carpet tiles

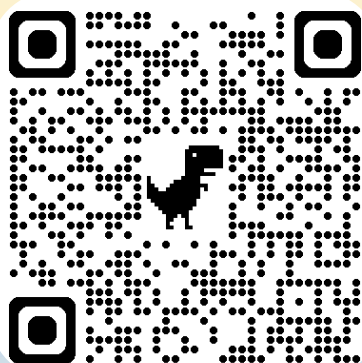
