“Is it better to adapt or stay the same?”

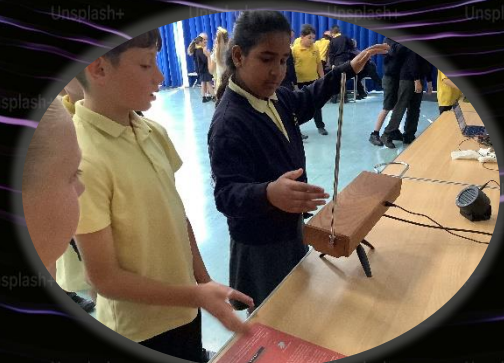

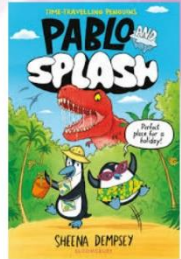

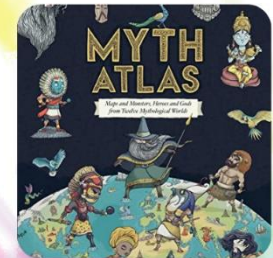
