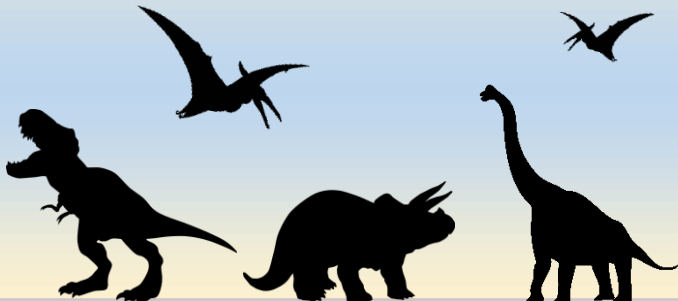


Our Big Question for this term is:

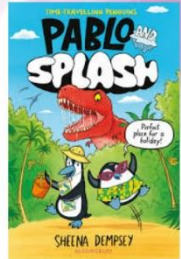

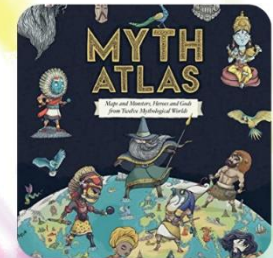
