The 35-minute show will run several times throughout the day to allow smaller audience groups (around 60 children per show). Delivered by Shooting Stars Theatre Company, the performance is designed to support children in developing strong minds and building positive self-esteem in a fun and engaging way.

Each class will also receive a packet of seeds and a wall chart to help them remember key strategies for looking after their mental health.
