



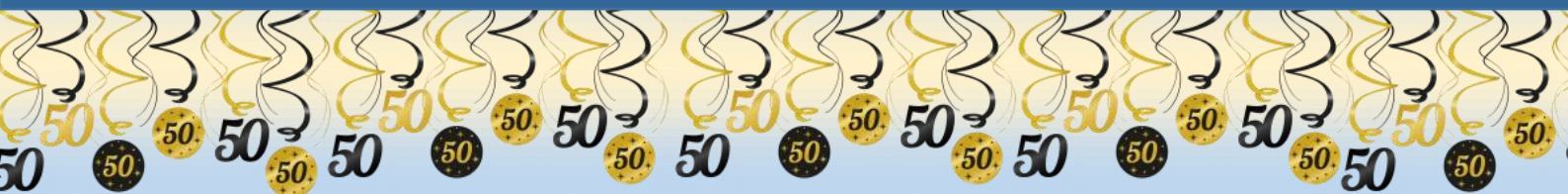
Bromstone's Brilliant 50th Anniversary Week!
