For information

Please be aware that if you would like your child to have paracetamol and/or ibuprofen during the school day, we would advise that you are available to come in to school to administer this. If your child is prescribed antibiotics from the Doctor, we can administer one of the doses if it to be taken 4 times a day. Medicines need to be in a named box and there is an online form that needs to be filled in. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.



Sports Clubs

In term 2 our Sports Clubs will run as general “sports clubs” (with the exception of gymnastics, girls football and dodgeball) meaning they will not be related to a specific sport for example football or rugby. The PE staff will deliver different sports depending on what is coming up on the Thanet Passport, which is a list of competitive and non-competitive fixtures, tournaments and festivals during the year. Please sign up on the Teacher2Parent App. Your child will need to be signed up on the register for each club they would like to attend. If your child does not appear on the register they will be unable to stay at the club. Key Stage 2 clubs (not dodgeball) will require football boots and shin pads.
