Maths Day Fun at Bromstone!

Today, everyone was off timetable, spending the whole day immersed in maths! Our buddy class events were running, with children designing their own times table games:

- EYFS explored equal and unequal groups, learning that two equal groups can be called a 'double', connecting this to finger patterns, and sorting odd and even numbers according to their 'shape'.
- Year 1 counted in multiples of 2, 5, and 10, recalling all doubles to 10 and the corresponding halves.
- Year 2 recalled and used multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5, and 10 times tables, recognising odd and even numbers.
- Year 3 focused on multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4, and 8 times tables.
- Year 4 worked on multiplication and division facts up to 12×12 .
- Year 5 & 6 revised all times tables and division facts up to 12×12 .

Some of our Year 2 children joined a TELT maths event in the hall from 9:30–11:30am, welcoming children from Garlinge, St Mildred's and Parkside schools to our site.

Everyone got creative for our dress-up day, coming in as numbers or rock stars! The excitement continued with our TELT Times Tables Rock Star battle, which has already started and is in full swing.

We wrapped up our day with assemblies: KS1 at 2:30pm and KS2 at 2:45pm, celebrating all the brilliant work and fantastic costume ideas.
