We were delighted to welcome Alex Stockley, a local boxer and former pupil of our school, who now runs T50 Boxing in Ramsgate. Alex led engaging, age-appropriate sessions with each year group, sharing his experiences and skills.

During the day, children explored important messages about conflict, including the risks of physical confrontation and the importance of self-discipline, respect and control, particularly in sports such as boxing. Alex also spoke openly about his own journey, including living with ADHD, which was both inspiring and relatable for many of our pupils.

It was a fantastic start to our new topic and a valuable learning experience for all.
