## Transition time at Bromstone

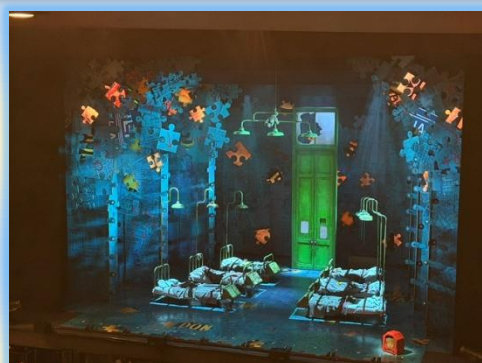
