Covid Updates

Children and young people aged 18 years and under who have a positive test result

It is not recommended that children and young people are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional.

If a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day they took the test, if they can. After 3 days, if they feel well and do not have a high temperature, the risk of passing the infection on to others is much lower. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.

Children and young people who usually go to school, college or childcare, and who live with someone who has a positive COVID-19 test result, should continue to attend as normal.



A few reminders for everyone

Children in year 6 will be sitting their SATs tests next week; please can all families with year 6 children ensure that the children are very punctual next week. Being on time will help children to relax and give their best efforts to help them reach their full potential.

During terms 5 and 6 please can you ensure that your child has a water bottle and sun-hat in school. If you would like your child to be wearing sun-cream, please can you apply this before they come to school.

It has come to our attention that some children in our school are playing games such as Call of Duty on their devices at home. Please be aware that these games are rated age 18 games. Therefore, it is completely inappropriate for any primary school aged children are accessing such games.
