Weekly Newsletter

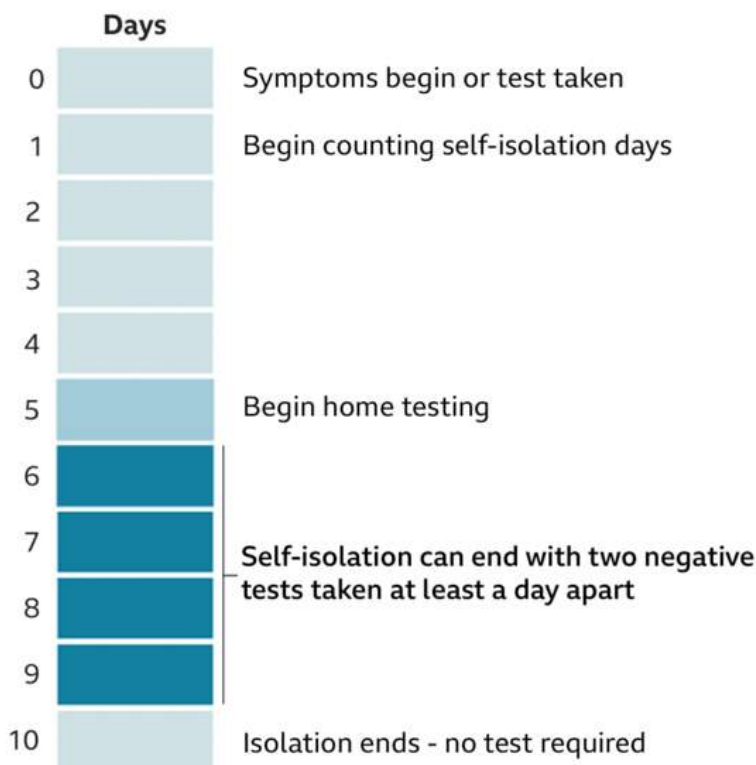
Week ending Friday 14th January 2022

This week the children have been delving further in to their learning topics with year 2 having been for a walk in the local community becoming “street detectives” and year 3 having their swimming lessons every Friday.

This week we have received and planted our Japanese Sakura cherry blossom tree from Japan to celebrate the UK’s enhanced relationship with Japan, to mark the Japan-UK Season of Culture.

The government have further updated their guidance regarding Covid-19. The updated guidance now states that when children and adults test negative using a lateral flow test on day 5 and day 6 (24 hours apart) they can return to school on day 6. You can continue to try to produce two negative lateral flow tests up until day 9. If you are still testing positive on day 9, you must stop testing and complete the full 10 days isolation and return on day 11. (Day 0 is the first day of symptoms or your positive lateral flow test outcome).
