Gate notices

The gates are only open from **8.40-8.50 am**. We will be promptly shutting the gates at 8.50am. Please ensure that your children are on time.

Breakfast Club entry is now at the main school entrance at the side of the school, next to the school car park. The gate will be open for 5 minutes from 8am – 8.05am. If you require a place at Breakfast Club or After School Club you will need to book this on-line at www.schoolmoney.co.uk It can no longer be booked via the office.

P.E.

Children will continue to come to school on their PE day wearing their PE kit. PE days are as follows:

Monday: Year 1

Tuesday: Year 3

Wednesday: Year 4

Thursday: Year 2 and Year 5

Friday: Year 6

If your child is attending an after-school sports club which does not fall on their PE day, they should wear their school uniform to school and change into their kit at the end of the day.

When your children are studying gymnastics, they have to be wearing shorts, t-shirt and bare feet in order to access the gymnastics apparatus, due to health and safety reasons. They can wear this underneath their tracksuit in colder weather. **When your children have a PE lesson on the field in the colder months, they will need football boots.** (This is for years 3,4,5 and 6 only.)

Cold Weather

Please can you ensure that your child is wearing a coat to school and a full tracksuit (navy blue or black) on their PE days as well as a coat. Depending on which sport is being delivered in PE lessons, children may also wear gloves and a hat, without any strings; this is advisable when the wind and weather is so cold.
