Important Notice re: Cystic Fibrosis

We write to you to inform you that we have a child in the school that has Cystic Fibrosis. Cystic Fibrosis is a genetic condition that predominantly affects the lungs and pancreas. It requires a large amount of treatment to keep the child well and healthy.

People with Cystic Fibrosis must not mix with another person with Cystic Fibrosis as they can pose a large infection risk to each other.

As part of our school risk assessment, we are notifying you to be aware of Cystic Fibrosis and ask that if there is anyone in your family that has the condition that could potentially attend the school/ or school events, that they make it known that they also have cystic fibrosis.

The school will take measures to ensure they are kept separate but at times may need to prioritise the child in our care. This means there could be times that we ask the adult not to attend the school event. This will be in their best interests to reduce the chance of cross infection and will be dealt with sensitively.
