Breakfast Club entry is now at the main school entrance at the side of the school next to the school car park. The gate will be open for 5 minutes from 8am – 8.05am. If you require a place at Breakfast Club or After School Club you will need to book this on-line at www.schoolmoneyco.uk. It can no longer be booked via the office.

Children will continue to come to school on their PE day wearing their PE kit. PE days are as follows:

Monday: Year 1
Tuesday: Year 3
Wednesday: Year 4
Thursday: Year 2 and Year 5
Friday: Year 6

The children are required to wear navy-blue or black shorts and a navy-blue Bromstone PE t-shirt. They need trainers OR plimsolls and for Years 3,4,5 and 6 they will also need football boots. They are allowed to wear a navy-blue or black tracksuit over the top of their PE kit but they will need to be wearing their shorts and t-shirt underneath the tracksuit for their gymnastics lessons, for health and safety reasons.
