### Term 4 PE

**All children need shorts and t-shirt for their indoor PE lesson as well as their tracksuit for their outdoor PE lesson.**

### For information

Please be aware that if you would like your child to have paracetamol and/or ibuprofen during the school day, you will need to come in to school to administer this. If your child is prescribed antibiotics from the Doctor, we can administer one of the doses if it is to be taken 4 times a day. Medicines need to be in a named box and there is an online form that needs to be filled in. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
