#### School dinner money

## With effect from 15<sup>th</sup> April (after the Easter break) the price of a school meal will be £2.50 per child.

The Government is continuing to support Universal Infant Free School meals; this means all children in Years R, 1 and 2 can be provided with a school meal free of charge. If your child is in Years 3 – 6, they can also have a free school meal if you are in receipt of certain allowances. All children who are entitled to free school meals also receive a voucher for food during the school holidays. This is currently £10 a child per week. If you believe you may be eligible please contact the school office for help in completing forms or complete the online form <u>here</u>.

#### Important news – Arbor and After School Clubs

### We will be sending out the logins and passwords for Arbor next Tuesday and the club booking for Term 5 will be going live to book on Wednesday at 1pm.
