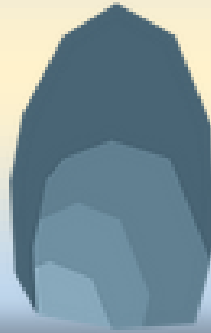
Star Player of the tournament was Alby!

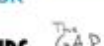
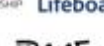
